How have toys changed?

Literacy

This half term we will be exploring a range of genres.

- Recounts
- Instructions
- Explanation texts
- Story

We will be learning to:

- Compose a sentence orally before writing
- Re read what we have written to check it makes sense
- Build on our knowledge of simple punctuation
- Use our phonetic knowledge to help us to spell

Numeracy

We will be learning to:

- Recognise and know the value of different coins and notes
- Represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations
- Solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division
- Compare, describe and solve practical problems for lengths and heights

Science

In science this half term we will be looking at different materials. We will:

- Identify and name a variety of everyday materials
- Describe the simple physical properties of materials
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials

Computing

We will be learning how to:

- Communicate ideas by selecting and adding text
- Enter and store information in a variety of forms (for example, storing information in a prepared database, saving work)
- Using the interactive whiteboard and a digital camera
- Stay safe whilst using a computer

Design & Technology

We will be making moving toys. We will:

- Explore and use mechanisms
- Select from and use a range of materials
