Mathematical Understanding

- Addition of a one-digit number or a multiple of 10 to a one-digit or two-digit number
- Subtraction of a one-digit number from a one-digit or two-digit number and a multiple of 10 from a two digit number
- Count on or back in ones, twos, fives and tens
- Use diagrams to sort objects
- Describe the position of objects and direction and distance
- Use the vocabulary of halves and quarters in context
- Sorting information, shapes or objects; display results using tables and pictures. Estimate, measure, weigh and compare
