NEW YEAR'S DAY DIP APPLICATION FORM

- Please arrive and meet at The Tank, East End Slip Beach at 10am on the day. Please check in with a Carnival Official in a Fluorescent Jacket. You will receive a unique ID no. after you have completed a registration form. You will need a unique ID No to take part.
All Dippers must be over 16 years of age, proof of age may be required.
The organiser reserves the right to stop any Dipper entering the water if they are deemed unsafe to take part.
Each Dipper must be able to demonstrate, to a suitable competent person, their ability to swim 50 metres in clothing. Anyone unable to meet these requirements is classified as a non-swimmer. Non-swimmers will be unable to take part.
No alcohol will be consumed by the Dipper at the event.
Marshals and First Aiders will be on the beach throughout the event. If you get into any difficulty please raise your hand.
NO throwing of objects will be allowed at any point during the Dip, either at the Dippers or into the public crowd. Failure to abide by this rule will result in expulsion from the event.
The race organiser will advise you of the course on the day and you are only going into ankle-deep water.
Each Dipper must be able to run into the sea unaided. Dippers must have a minimum of aggressive and passive white water self-rescue skills.
If a Dipper is asked to assist with a situation, this must be obeyed. There will be a Dippers' Briefing prior to them entering the sea.
