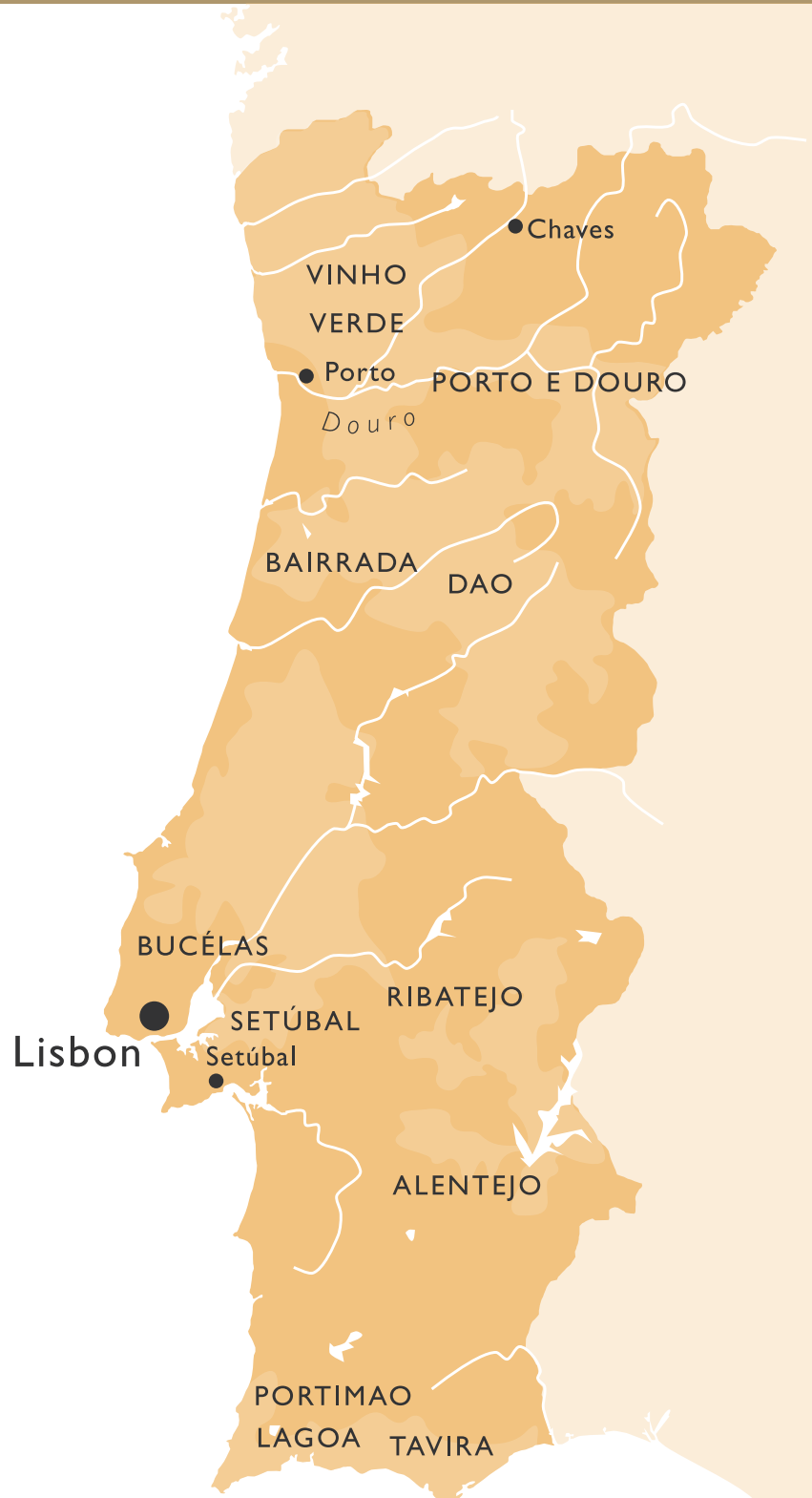


Portugal
