## *Bodegas Bórbore, San Juan*

*The history of Bórbore winery dates from 1936, when Don Jose Bórbore, an Italian immigrant, started his industrial activity by creating a small winery. The place chosen was at the foot of the Pie de Palo mountain range, in the Tulum valley that is the main winemaking region of San Juan.*

*In the year 2000 the winery was purchased by the Berzenkovich Pulenta family, who have a long winemaking tradition in the region. Aiming at a vanguard viticulture, they established new investment and development plans for the future bringing their Argentinian wines to a global market.*

*A yellow green in colour with gold flecks, this characteristically fresh wine has both citrus and floral notes, particularly roses, both on the nose and on the palate. (2) 13.5%vol.*
