



Quady Winery, California

Quady Winery's trailblazing habit began with Andrew Quady's first discovery of a little used patch of Orange Muscat grapes in a small valley town in California. In 1980, Andrew made these grapes into Essensia, a wine unlike any the American wine industry had ever known. Essensia marked the birth of a new kind of winery where rich flavours of rare Muscat varietals are celebrated and intensified rather than blended and softened. Michael Blaylock joined the Company in 1984 and under his direction, Quady Winery consistently wins top marks in its category.



Orange Muscat, Essensia, Quady



From 100% Orange Muscat with an aroma reminiscent of orange blossom and apricot, and a lingering refreshing aftertaste, Essensia is used as a dessert accompaniment or a dessert in itself. The Orange Muscat grape variety is little known. It was once grown in France and there are some small plantings in Italy and Australia. The wine is lightly fortified to about 15% alcohol and aged for 3 months in French Oak. The wine tastes balanced, like the taste of fresh fruit. (8) 15%vol.
