Traditionally made, yet exhibiting some modern touches such as ripe fruit, the 2006 Potensac is another sleeper of the vintage from this estate, owned by Jean-Hubert Delon, the proprietor of Léoville Las Cases. Classic Bordeaux notes of red and blackcurrants, earth, and spice box are well-presented in this deep ruby/purple-colored, medium-bodied wine, which should drink nicely for a decade or more.
