## Domaine Laroche, Chablis

*The name Domaine Laroche is virtually synonymous with Chablis. For three generations, the Laroche family has been dedicated to producing top quality wines from the Chablis region.*

*Chablis' Grand Cru and Premier Cru vineyards are planted primarily on the region's unique Kimmeridgian soil which contributes to the distinctively mineral and flinty characters, steely, floral bouquet, delicate, crisp, refined flavours and elegance of these wines that have become so prized throughout the world.*

*Laroche believes passionately that the best wines can only be made using the finest grapes. The approach to viticulture is to create optimal conditions to achieve top quality fruit - purity and typicity being the heart of the Laroche philosophy. In its vineyards in Chablis and the South of France, the same process of selecting exceptional sites had been followed with an adaptation to the local cultivation methods. Grégory Viennois, Technical Director, and his team shares this view and work in tune with nature, encouraging low yields and natural ecology to produce ripe fruit that is true to its vineyard origins.*



### Chablis Saint Martin, Domaine Laroche



*Cuvée Saint-Martin is a blend of the best plots of Domaine Laroche in Chablis appellation. Thanks to their numerous nuances, they bring richness and complexity to the final wine. Pale gold in colour, with an intense nose with hints of ripe white fruit and spring blossom. The ripe fruit flavours, in the mouth, are balanced by zesty acidity and a lingering fruity finish.
