In the rain-shadow of the Vosges Mountains, this unique region of France is famed particularly for aromatic whites such as Riesling and Gewürztraminer and is capable of producing wines that achieve higher alcohol levels while retaining the cool, aromatic edge. Beautifully presented in the classic Alsace flute, a wine from Producer Michel Leon of the Arthur-Metz group is a must for any good list.
